6	Must have stock attached and fired from shoulder position **Note: Sig Brace and any variant thereof is not allowed—must be attached to the carbine and fired from the shoulder**	Yes
7	Sling use authorized	Yes
8	Optical sight/electronic sights permitted	Open YES, Limited NO
9	Compensators /Muzzle Brakes permitted	Open YES, Limited NO
10	Flash Hiders permitted	Yes, both divisions
11	Suppressors permitted	Open YES, Limited NO
12	Start Position (Low Ready is defined as both hands on the carbine, buttstock seated on shoulder. Head may be on buttstock or above.)	Low ready pointed at aiming flag, safety off, finger off of trigger but may be inside trigger guard
13	Handling requirements	Must be carried with the muzzle vertical, bolt open, chamber flag installed. May not move from the vertical position until the Make Ready command is given, violations will be subject to Unsafe Gun Handling disqualification.

Special Conditions:

There will be two Divisions, Open and Limited.

- 1) Short Barreled Rifles (SBR's) are permitted provided that the competitor is in full compliance with all laws and regulations concerning ownership and transport of the SBR.
- 2) Suppressors are permitted in PCC Open division, provided that the competitor is in full compliance with all laws and regulations concerning ownership, use, and transport of the suppressor. Be advised that timers may not pick up suppressed gunfire.
